
We offer supportive services to teens and families:





## 1 IN 3 TEENS, HAVE EXPERIENCED DATING VIOLENCE



### I have the right to:

- Trust myself and my instincts
- Be respected as a person
- Change my mind
- Express my feelings
- Refuse a date
- Not be physically, emotionally, or sexually abused



#### TEENS ARE EXPERIANCING SEXUAL VIOLENCE AT AN ALARMING RATE.

44% of reported sexual assaults are youth under age 18.

Ages 16-19 are at the greatest risk.

4 out of 5 assaults are perpetrated by someone known to the victim. Consent is a mutual agreement with a clearly stated YES. Coercion is not consent!
