- * Volunteer opportunities in Youth Community Action Teams, center programs, outreach activities, and more!

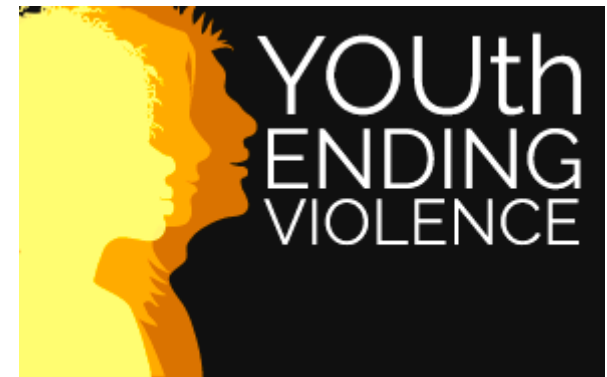

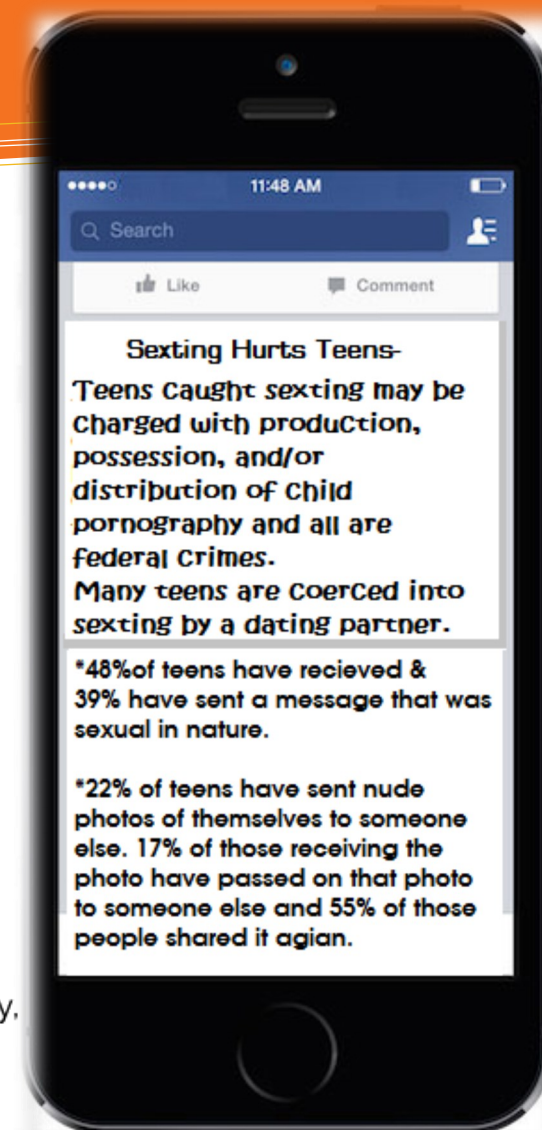

The Dating Bill of Rights

TEENS ARE EXPERIENCING SEXUAL VIOLENCE AT AN ALARMING RATE.

44% of reported sexual assaults are youth under age 18.

Ages 16-19 are at the greatest risk.

4 out of 5 assaults are perpetrated by someone known to the victim.

Consent is a mutual agreement with a clearly stated YES. Coercion is not consent!
